Selection criteria for outgoing students and PhD candidates for study exchange within the framework of Erasmus+ KA171-2022 Third Countries not Associated with the Programme (partner countries)

I. General selection criteria

- 1. Candidates for outgoing mobilities within the framework of the Erasmus+ Partner Countries Programme are selected by a committee consisting of at least three individuals headed by the Institutional Coordinator of the Erasmus+ Programme.
- 2. Candidates that have not been nominated previously for the Erasmus+ Programme will be given a priority. In the case of obtaining the same amount of points by several candidates, the candidate with priority will be nominated for the mobility.
- 3. Candidates have to obtain at least 60 points in the selection procedure in order to be eligible to take part in the Erasmus+ Partner Countries Programme.
- 4. In order to be nominated for the mobility it is obligatory to have a command of English or of the language of instruction of the host university at a level sufficient to carry out the mobility minimum B2. A candidate that will not obtain 5 points from at least one language criterion will not be qualified for the exchange.
- 5. Participation in the call for application is on condition that the candidate has sufficient mobility capital to spend a semester at a partner university. The following programmes are taken into consideration in the calculation of the mobility capital: Erasmus+ programme countries / mobility of students and staff of higher education institutions between EU countries and third countries associated with Erasmus+ (KA103, KA131 mobilities for studies, traineeships, short-term mobilities including BIP), Erasmus+ partner countries / study exchange within the framework of Erasmus+ Third Countries not Associated with the Programme (KA107, KA171) and Erasmus LLP.
- 6. Previous resignation from an awarded outgoing mobility within the Erasmus+ Partner Countries Programme will result in the deduction of 10 points from the final score of the selection procedure.
- 7. Candidates have to have Jagiellonian University's student/ PhD candidate status at the moment of the all for application and during the whole duration of the mobility.
- 8. Student/ PhD candidate cannot be on a dean's leave or a student leave in the course of the mobility.

II. Students of first-cycle, second-cycle and long-cycle studies are assessed on the basis of the following criteria:
